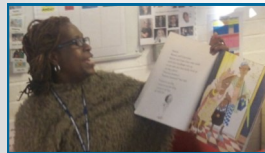

Parents' Evenings

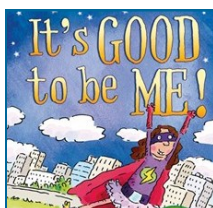
