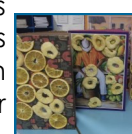
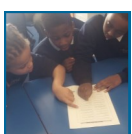

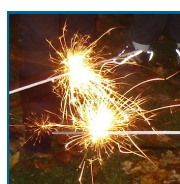
Black History Month
