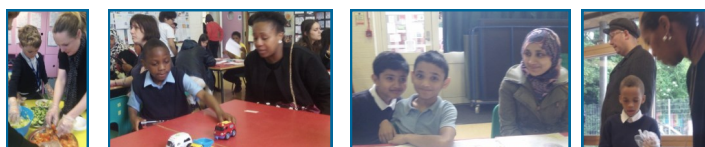
## Recognition Of Commitment from UNICEF

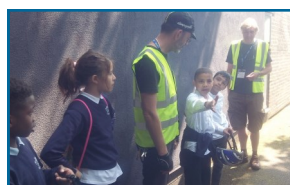

### SRE Curriculum Meeting

Thank you to parents who attended the SRE curriculum meeting on Tuesday when Ms Williams provided an outline of the SRE programme taught at Ashmole and answered questions from parents. The Department for Education recognises the need for SRE at all key stages and encourages schools to develop their own lesson content with support from expert sources. Ashmole have worked with Lambeth Health Education Link Service and our lessons encourage children to develop the skills of listening, empathy, talking about feelings and relationships with families and friends. If parents/carers wish to withdraw their children from SRE lessons the School must be informed in writing.

### Bikeability Training



Well done to our pupils in Years 5 and 6 who took part in Bikeability training this week. All pupils were awarded with level 1 certificates. The course involved aspects of bicycle maintenance and safety and pupils demonstrated that they could cycle safely on roads in the local area.
