## Enterprise Fair

Ashmole's inaugural Enterprise Fair took place on Thursday 7th July. The Fair was the culmination of an exciting Enterprise Fortnight during which pupils designed and made food and crafts linked to their topics of study to sell to pupils and parents alike. Every class made a profit after the expenses of their ingredients and materials were deducted from their cash takings on the day. Over £300 was raised in total which will be donated to the chosen charity of the pupils, WaterAid.



## Pupil Performance Outcomes

Some of the assessment information about the academic outcomes for our pupils is published nationally. This includes the number of pupils working at the expected standard or above at the end of EYFS, end of KS1 and end of KS2 as well as the outcomes from the Year 1 phonics screening check. The provisional data that we have received indicates that the outcomes for Ashmole pupils are significantly above national and Lambeth averages in all areas. Thank you to our parent community for your continued support, to our staff team for their dedication to achieve the best for our pupils and to the children themselves for their hard work and excellent behaviour which make these improved results possible. We look forward to sharing the data with you in detail during the autumn term.
