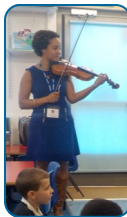
Ashmole Pupils Perform at The National Theatre



Year 1 pupils delighted parents and carers with a fantastic performance at The National Theatre last week. The pupils have taken part in several in-school workshops led by theatre practitioners and they put their learning into action with their songs, sounds, props and dances. Pupils benefitted from their 'behind the scenes' look at how the theatre works and have a better understanding of how many different people it takes to produce a performance. Their experiences are already benefitting their own work around story telling as part of their work in English.

The cellist and violinist performed in assembly and then visited classrooms throughout the day before leading a masterclass workshop with some of our violinists in the afternoon. The visiting musicians, who regularly play with leading orchestras, were impressed by the musical appreciation and understanding of Ashmole pupils.



The Mayans Brought To Life



This week, Years 5 and 6 had their topic of Ancient Civilisations brought to life through drama activities led by actors from The Freshwater Theatre Company. Pupils used their imaginations to become characters from the Mayan world and journeyed around the Mayan city-state of Palenque, learning about the people, religion and culture of this ancient civilisation. The drama work helped them to consider what eventually led to the collapse of this civilisation.



Year 4 Residential

Year 4 pupils enjoyed 3 fantastic days at Downe Activity Centre in Kent last week. The pupils tested their bravery, determination and teamwork when taking part in activities including archery, zip-wire, climbing, abseiling, go-karting and the 15 metre high 'leap of faith' climb and jump.
