This term our learning will be based around the theme of  
**'How other people live: Greece'**

Children will learn about the following...

**Maths:** Children will revise telling and writing the time from an analogue clock, including reading roman numerals. They will solve problems involving duration and the difference between times using an empty number line. Children will learn to read, interpret and present data using graphs.

**English:** Children will be reading and studying Greek myths and writing their own versions. They will make leaflets and posters to persuade people to buy our goods at the Enterprise fair.

**Science:** Children will be looking at healthy diets and exercise and comparing today's to those of the Ancient Greeks.

**Geography:** Children will learn about rivers and mountains. They will learn how they are formed and about some of the world's most famous examples.

**History:** Children will learn about the Ancient Greeks, including their lifestyle, customs and notable achievements.

**Art/DT:** Children will focus on creating art and pottery in the style of the Ancient Greeks.

**PE:** multiskills

**RE:** Islamic rites of passage

**Computing:** multimedia

**Music:** Reflect, Rewind and Replay (Charanga)

**Spanish:** days and months

**PSHE and Citizenship:** sex and relationships education

**You can help your child to succeed by doing the following:**

- Encourage your child to read their reading book every day and ask them about what has happened in the story – don't forget to sign and date in their reading record book!
- Daily spelling practice
- Practising times table facts up to 10x10 daily
- Supporting your child in becoming more independent in getting organised for school; packing their own bag and remembering the things they'll need.
