This term our learning will be based around the theme of

'How other people live: France'

Children will learn about the following...

Maths: Children will revisit time to consolidate reading the clock to half past the hour. We will also begin to look at multiplication as repeated addition (adding the same number several times).

English: We will complete various English activities around our performance at the National Theatre. We will also be working with a text with familiar settings and characters and writing our own simple versions.

Science: Sound and light. Children will learn about different sources of light and sound and how we see and hear them.

Art/DT: Children will focus on the work of French artist Henri Rousseau this term, creating work in his style. Children will also be cooking for the Enterprise Fair.

Geography: The pupils will focus on France; identifying it on a map and making comparisons about life there and in the UK.

History: Children will study a key event from French history.

PE: Athletics/Mighty Movers

Computing: multimedia

RE: books and stories

PSHE and Citizenship: sex and relationships education: growing and caring for ourselves
