This term our learning will be based around the theme of

'How other people live: France'

Children will learn about the following...

Maths: As well as working on measurements, maths this term will be linked directly to our 'Enterprise Fortnight' with a big focus on money, making totals and calculating change.

English: Poetry and narrative will be explored this term, as well as non-fiction which will link to enterprise through creating marketing materials and evaluating them.

Science: Forces and movement. Children will observe and describe how some objects move and the factors that can affect this, such as gravity and friction.

Art/DT: Children will focus on the work of French artist Henri Rousseau this term, creating work in his style. Children will also be cooking for the Enterprise Fair.

Geography: The pupils will focus on France; identifying it on a map and making comparisons about life there and in the UK.

History: Children will study a key event from French history.
