This term our learning will be based around the theme of

## 'How other people live: Egypt'

Children will learn about the following...

**Maths:** Children will be learning to tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including reading roman numerals. Pupils will learn to calculate durations and the difference between times. Children will also learn to read, interpret and present data using graphs.

**English:** Children will be reading and studying Greek myths and writing their own versions. Children will be using persuasive language to create holiday brochures about Egypt as well as leaflets advertising our product for the Enterprise Fair.

**Science:** Children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of plants and will understand the life cycle of a flowering plant.

**Geography:** Children will focus on Egypt and in particular how the river Nile has shaped how people live there.

**History:** Children will learn about the ancient Egyptians, their beliefs and customs.

**Art/DT:** Children will create papyrus paintings in the style of Ancient Egypt. They will also be cooking for the Enterprise Fair.

**PE:** multiskills

**RE:** special books and sacred texts

**Computing:** multimedia

**Music:** Reflect, Rewind and Replay (Charanga)

**Spanish:** days and months

**PSHE and Citizenship:** sex and relationships education: valuing difference and keeping safe.
