This term our learning will be based around the theme of

## 'How other people live: Egypt'

Children will learn about the following...

**Maths:** Children will be continuing to tell the time, read timetables and use an empty number line to find the difference between times. Children will be collecting data, using this to construct a graph and interpreting the graph.

**English:** Children will be reading and studying Egyptian myths and writing their own versions. Children will be researching facts on Egypt past and present and will then use the information to produce leaflets and posters to persuade people to visit Egypt.

**Science:** Living things and their habitats. Children will group and classify animals and their habitats according to their features, explaining their reasons.

**Geography:** Children will focus on Egypt and in particular how the river Nile has shaped how people live there.

**History:** Children will learn about the ancient Egyptians, their beliefs and customs.

**Art/DT:** Children will create papyrus paintings in the style of Ancient Egypt. They will also be cooking for the Enterprise Fair.
