School Uniform Policy

All Ashmole children, from Nursery up to Year 6 are expected to wear the school uniform.

Uniforms allow the children to feel a sense of belonging, the opportunity to wear comfortable, practical clothes and to be a visual part of an organisation.

At Ashmole the expectation is that all children follow the uniform policy and wear named uniform to school and for their PE sessions.

The uniform is as follows:

Clothing

- Navy, grey or black trousers/tracksuit trousers/shorts/leggings/skirts/pinafore dress
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- White, light blue or grey polo shirt or shirt
- Blue and white gingham check summer dress
- Hijabs, rather than head scarves, can only be worn if in accordance with religious observation must be plain black, grey or navy blue

Footwear

- Black school shoes must be worn by all pupils (closed toe pumps or sandals and plain black trainers without logos are acceptable)
- Shoes with heels or open toes are not allowed

Bags & PE Kit

- Ashmole School Book Bag Carrier or Ashmole Hi Visibility Dispatch Bag
- Ashmole PE bag containing t-shirt in house team colours, dark shorts/jogging trousers, plimsolls or trainers

Jewellery, make-up and accessories

- Jewellery (other than small stud earrings and watches) should not be worn
- Scarves or hats are not to be worn in school
- Make-up (including nail varnish and lip gloss) is not allowed

All items of school uniform should be clearly named so that any misplaced items can be returned to the right pupil.
